Special Temporary Authorization

Dear Mr. Barbee:

This is in reference to the request filed July 14, 2009, on behalf of The Turning Leaf, Inc. ("TLI"). TLI requests extension of the special temporary authority ("STA") granted on February 3, 2009, to operate Station KZXL (formerly KLJK) from a site other than the licensed site. In support of the request, TLI states that it has not yet been able to prepare and file an application for construction permit.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Our review indicates that the licensee has been prevented from restoring licensed operation due to causes beyond its control and has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem. Thus, extension of STA is warranted.

¹ KZXL is licensed for operation on Channel 242A (96.3 MHz) with effective radiated power of 1.35 kilowatts (H&V) and antenna height above average terrain of 212 meters.

Accordingly, the request for extension of STA IS HEREBY GRANTED. Station KZXL may continue to operate with the following facilities:

KZXL must notify the Commission when licensed operation is restored. KZXL must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR § 1.1310.

This authority expires on February 13, 2010.
