This letter refers to the above-captioned application for a new non-commercial educational FM station to serve Blowout, Texas.

By letter dated May 22, 2009 (enclosed), the Commission stated that the site elevation discrepancy must be resolved. Furthermore, NWC was given 30 days in which to respond to the letter. In the letter the Commission stated "[f]ailure to respond within this time period will result in the dismissal of the application for failure to prosecute pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 73.3568(a)(1)."

Dear Applicant:

This is in reference to the above-captioned application for a new noncommercial/educational FM station to serve Blowout, Texas on Channel 205A.

Our study has revealed a discrepancy in the site elevation. Specifically, the application indicates that the site elevation is 536 meters, whereas Tower Registration No. 1050231 shows the site elevation to be 427.3 meters.¹ Accordingly, this discrepancy must be resolved. Please note, if the site elevation in the application is changed, all pertinent sections and exhibits to the application, including the antenna height figures, must be corrected.

Further action on the subject application will be withheld for a period of thirty (30) days from the date of this letter to provide an opportunity to respond. Failure to respond within this time period or to provide written updates every thirty days thereafter will result in the dismissal of the application for failure to prosecute pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 73.3568(a)(1).
