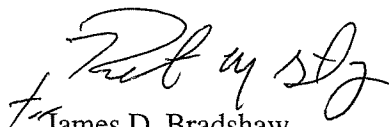
This is in reference to the request filed March 4, 2009, on behalf of The River Educational Media, Inc. ("River"), licensee of W279AG, Atlantic Beach, Florida. River requests special temporary authority ("STA") to rebroadcast the programming of AM Station WBOB(AM), licensed to Chesapeake-Portsmouth Broadcasting Corporation in Jacksonville, Florida, on FM Translator W279AG. In support of the request, River states that WBOB(AM) is unable to provide an interference-free signal to the area as a result of interference from adjacent-channel stations.

Having given the proposal thorough consideration, we find that the Public Interest would be served by grant of River's request.

Accordingly, the request for STA IS HEREBY GRANTED. Station WBOB(AM) may rebroadcast its programming on FM Translator W279AG. River must take whatever steps are necessary to prevent exposure of workers and/or the public to radio frequency fields in excess of the Commission's exposure limits. See 47 CFR Sections 1.1307(b), 1.1310.

This authority expires on **October 14, 2009**.
