## Dear Licensee:

This refers to the above-captioned license application filed by Venture Technologies Group, LLC (VTG) for a license to cover construction for Station KRPE-LP, Banning, California.

The subject application is intended to cover the construction authorized in an application for displacement relief.<sup>1</sup> The displacement application, in turn, was a proposed minor change to the original authorized and outstanding construction permit.<sup>2</sup> The original construction period was to expire 3 years from the grant of the initial construction permit, or March 22, 2004. The grant of the displacement application did not extend the original construction period established by the original construction permit.<sup>3</sup> However, the authorization issued on FCC Form 346 attendant to the grant of the displacement application incorrectly listed a construction deadline of September 1, 2009.

It is therefore apparent that expiration date listed on the displacement authorization was erroneous, a fact that VTG knew or should have known. Even if the authorization as issued was incorrect, that error cannot be perpetuated or turned into a

windfall of rights to which VTG would not otherwise be entitled.<sup>4</sup> Accordingly, we find that the construction permit for this facility has expired and, therefore, the subject license application must be dismissed. Nevertheless, VTG is free to apply for a new digital television station in the market in an upcoming filing window.

In light of the above, IT IS ORDERED That the license application (BLTVL-20090819AHG) filed by Venture Technologies Group, LLC, IS DISMISSED; the license for Station KRPE-LP, Banning, CA IS FORFEITED, and the call sign IS HEREBY DELETED.
