Dear Licensee:

This refers to the above-captioned application for Special Temporary Authority filed on behalf of Venture Technologies Group, LLC (VTG) for Station WBTL-LP. The application states that the station has been silent since August 6, 2008.

Section 312(g) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, provides in pertinent part that if a broadcasting station fails to transmit broadcast signals for any consecutive 12-month period, then the station license shall expire at the end of that period.¹

Accordingly, the license for station WBTL-LP IS FORFEITED, and the call sign IS HEREBY DELETED. Moreover, in view of this action, the above-captioned application for Special Temporary Authority for the station to remain silent is moot, and IS HEREBY DIMISSED.
