Dear Applicant:

This is with respect to the above-referenced request for Special Temporary Authority (“STA”) for station KIDA(TV), analog channel 5, Sun Valley, Idaho, to remain silent, filed by Marcia T. Turner d/b/a Turner Enterprises. According to the STA request, the station went silent on June 12, 2009, which is the date by which Congress mandated that all full-power television stations cease broadcasting an analog signal, except for limited analog “nightlight” service.¹

Digital channel 5 was allotted at Sun Valley for post-transition operations.² The Commission, however, never received an application for a construction permit to construct the station’s post-transition digital facility on channel 5. Because the analog license for KIDA(TV) terminated on June 12, 2009 at 11:59:59 pm local time,³ and you failed to apply for a construction permit to construct a post-transition digital facility prior to that date, you no longer have authority to operate a television station at Sun Valley.

In view of the foregoing, the above-referenced STA request IS HEREBY DISMISSED and the call sign for the station IS HEREBY DELETED. Channel 5 remains allotted to Sun Valley, Idaho, and when the Commission lifts the freeze on the filing of applications for new stations, that channel will be available for application.
