On September 1, 2009, the licensee as addressed above was sent a deficiency letter outlining the following interference problems:

Our preliminary engineering review reveals that your proposed facility does not comply with the Commission's interference rules. Specifically, the proposal is predicted to cause interference to the following facilities:

- 1. WJDE-LP, Nashville, TN. BLTTA-20001208AEY
- 2. WNTU-LP, Nashville, TN. BLTTL-20001018ABZ

You were given the opportunity to file a minor amendment to resolve these specified interference problems within (30) days from the date of this letter. Amendments must be filed electronically. If not so amended, your application will be considered incomplete and subsequently dismissed.

Our records indicate that an amendment was filed on October 1, 2009, in response to the above referenced 30 day letter. Our engineering review, including the specification of the amendment, reveals that your facility still does not comply with the Commission's interference rules. Specifically, the proposal is predicted to cause interference to the following facilities:

1. WJDE-LP, Nashville, TN. - BLTTA-20001208AEY

As a result of the continued interference issue as outlined above, the above referenced application is considered incomplete and IS HEREBY DISMISSED.
