Dear Applicant:

We are currently processing your above-referenced application. Our preliminary engineering review reveals that your proposed facility does not comply with the Commission's interference rules. Specifically, the proposal is predicted to cause interference to WUND-TV, BLEDT-20070307ABK, Ch. 20, Edenton, NC and W18BS, BLTTL-19961118JG, Ch. 18, Hampton, VA. Full-service emission mask was proposed. However, this mask specification is not acceptable. Also, a search of the FCC tower registration database,found at http://wtbwww05.fcc.gov/antenna/ASRQuery.html, reveals that discrepancies exist between the data listed for the antenna tower structure referenced in your application and the FCC's tower registration database. (Please note that all coordinates found in the FCC tower registration database are NAD 83 and that the conversion from NAD 27 may be required before requesting a search.)

You are required to electronically amend your application to resolve these specified problems within (30) days of the date of this letter. If not so amended electronically, your application will be CONSIDERED INCOMPLETE AND SUBSEQUENTLY DISMISSED.
