This letter is in reference to the above-captioned minor change application filed by 1TV to modify Construction Permit. BP-20071107ACH by changing the KBSZ(AM) transmitter site and its antenna system, our letter dated November 4, 2009, requesting a curative amendment; and the November 10, 2009, amendment.

A preliminary review of the application, as amended, reveals that the environmental statement is unacceptable. To be specific, since the proposed facility involves new construction, 1TV must certify that the entire Form 620 process has been completed. Accordingly, further action on the subject application will be withheld for a period of 180 days from the date of this letter to provide an opportunity to amend the application.
