## Dear Licensees:

This is with respect to the application filed by Alpha & Omega Communications, LLC ("Alpha"), the licensee of KCLP-CA, Boise, Idaho, requesting review of the March 8, 2007 letter decision affirming an earlier decision rescinding KCLP-CA's Class A television status on channel 38. Commission records show, however, that the Commission granted Alpha's displacement application for channel 18 at Boise in 2004, and that facility has since been constructed and licensed as a Class A television station. Accordingly, Alpha's application for review IS DISMISSED AS MOOT.
