
On behalf of All Classical Public Media, Inc. ("All Classical"), this letter is written pursuant to Section 73.1740(a)(4) of the Commission's rules to notify the Commission that Noncommercial Educational FM Broadcast Station KQDL, Hood River, Oregon, signed off the air on November 17, 2009.

KQDL signed off as part of a process which ultimately will result in the improvement of noncommercial educational radio service to the area by All Classical and by Oregon Public Broadcasting ("OPB"). By agreement of the parties, the license for KQDL, which had been simulcasting the signal of All Classical's KQAC, Portland, will be assigned to OPB. The area continues to receive the programming of KQAC via All Classical's Station KQHR, The Dalles, Oregon.

All Classical will in due course request Special Temporary Authority for KQDL to remain silent.
