On behalf of WOOF, Inc., licensee of FM translator station W261AT, Dothan, Alabama, this letter is to notify the Commission that W261AT has resumed on-air operations as of February 1, 2010, and is now operating pursuant to automatic program test authority consistent with the parameters contained in its underlying construction permit FCC File No. BPFT-20091203AGT. Consistent with the FCC's Rules, WOOF, Inc. has filed electronically a license application covering the modifications made to the station pursuant to the construction permit and addressing any special operating conditions. (See FCC File No. BLFT-20100127AAT.) Thus, FM translator W261AT is now operating with its full authorized parameters and is rebroadcasting the signal of commonly owned AM station, WOOF(AM), Dothan, Alabama (FIN-73675).
