Dear Licensee:

This addresses the authorization for the above-captioned station, KJCP-LP, Channel 38, Pago Pago, American Samoa. Also pending is the above-captioned application to assign the KJCP-LP license to South Seas Broadcasting, Inc.

A review of the Commission's records reveals that station KJCP-LP has been silent since March 25, 2007. A previously granted application for Special Temporary Authority for the station to remain silent expired on September 25, 2007.<sup>1</sup>

Section 312(g) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, provides in pertinent part that if a broadcasting station fails to transmit broadcast signals for any consecutive 12-month period, then the station license shall expire at the end of that period.<sup>2</sup>

Accordingly, the license for station KJCP-LP IS FORFEITED, and the call sign IS HEREBY DELETED. In addition, pending application to assign the station license to South Seas Broadcasting, Inc. IS DISMISSED.
