Dear Counsel:

This is in reference to the request filed March 29, 2010, on behalf of Educational Media Foundation ("EMF"). EMF requests special temporary authority ("STA") to operate Station KSTN-FM temporarily with its authorized facilities. In support of the request, EMF states that it completed construction of facilities authorized by Construction Permit BPED-20070119AFL and filed License application BLED-20080402ACU; however, it has been silent since April 17, 2009, due to an FAA interference issue. EMF states that it is working with the FAA to resolve the issue, but that resolution will not occur in time to prevent the loss of the station's license on April 17, 2010. EMF states that it has obtained approval from the FAA for temporary resumption of operation, and requests STA in order to preserve its license, during the overnight hours of April 1-2 or April 6-7.

Our review indicates that the Public Interest would be served by grant of the requested STA.

Accordingly, the request for STA IS HEREBY GRANTED. Station KSTN-FM may operate with the facilities authorized by Construction Permit BPED-20070119AFL, in coordination with the FAA, as discussed above.

This authority expires on **April 8, 2010**.
