This letter is in reference to: (1) the above-captioned minor change application to change effective radiated power, antenna height, and transmitter site; (2) the May 11, 2007 Request to Defer Processing filed by KCBX, Inc. ("KCBX"); and (3) all other related pleadings. For the reasons set forth herein, we deny the Request to Defer Processing and grant the application.

On May 11, 2007, KCBX filed a Request to Defer Processing of KPBS's site re-location application until the Commission authorizes changes in stations KSBX(FM), Santa Barbara, CA and KLFH(FM), Ojai, CA. KCBX is requesting a waiver of 47 C.F.R. § 73.509 in its pending application to allow KSBX and KLFH to alleviate interference from KPBS's current facility.

In the Request to Defer Processing, KCBX fails to state that the KPBS's proposed facilities would violate any of the Commission's rules, regulations, or policies. Furthermore, an engineering study of the application reveals that the application is acceptable for filing and grantable. Therefore, we will not delay the processing of the instant application while the waiver request filed by KCBX for KSBX and KLFH is under consideration.

In light of the above, the Request to Deny Processing IS HEREBY DENIED and application BPED-20070327ADY IS HEREBY GRANTED. These actions are taken pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 0.283.
