Dear Applicant:

This refers to the above-captioned minor change non-commercial educational application filed to modify the broadcast facilities of Station WZXE.

An engineering review of the application reveals that the application fails to comply with Section 73.525¹ of the Commission's Rules (the "Rules") with respect to TV Channel Six station, WPVI-DT, Philadelphia, PA. Specifically, WXZE's interference analysis in Exhibit 19 is insufficient to demonstrate compliance with Section 73.525. Furthermore, our predicted interference studies indicate an interference area much different than provided in the exhibit. Accordingly, we will dismiss the application.²

In light of the above, Application BMPED-20100324AAE is unacceptable for filing pursuant to 47 C.F.R. Section 73.3566(a) and is **HEREBY DISMISSED**. This action is taken pursuant to 47 C.F.R. Section 0.283.
