

**FM BROADCAST STATION LICENSE
MAIN AND AUXILIARY ANTENNAS**

Subject to the provisions of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, treaties, and Commission Rules, and further subject to conditions set forth in this license, ¹ the LICENSEE:

MICHIANA TELECASTING CORP.

is hereby authorized to use and operate the radio transmitting apparatus hereinafter described for the purpose of broadcasting the term ending 3 a.m. Local Time:

The licensee shall use and operate said apparatus only in accordance with the following terms:

MAIN: (RCA, BFJ-2AR) 2 sections, circularly polarized. Antenna is to be side-mounted at the 820 foot level C/R cross-section, guyed steel tower, which is top-mounted with the TV antenna of Station WNDU-TV. OHAG: 1069 (Incl. TV ant.)
AUX.: RCA, BFA-6, 6 sections, side-mounted at the approx. 431' level of a uniform cross section, guyed tower. OHAG: 545 feet.

The licensee shall, during the term of this license, render such broadcasting service as will serve public interest, convenience, or necessity to the full extent of the privileges herein conferred.

This license shall not vest in the licensee any right to operate the station nor any right in the use of the frequency designated in the license beyond the term hereof, nor in any other manner than authorized herein. Neither the license nor the right granted hereunder shall be assigned or otherwise transferred in violation of the Communications Act of 1934. This license is subject to the right of use or control by the Government of the United States conferred by section 606 of the Communications Act of 1934.
