On behalf of the Arizona Board of Regents for the benefit of The University of Arizona ("ABOR"), licensee of radio station KUAZ(AM), Tucson, Arizona, we hereby notify the Commission of the commencement of digital broadcasting using iBiquity Digital Corporation's HD Radio<sup>TM</sup> technology. Consistent with the Commission's order on interim digital operations in Digital Audio Broadcasting Systems and Their Impact on the Terrestrial Radio Broadcast Service, MM Docket No. 99-325, First Report and Order (October 11, 2002), ABOR supplies the attached information in support of this notification.

ABOR qualifies as a governmental entity and is also a noncommercial educational licensee which operates Station KUAZ(AM) on a noncommercial educational basis. This station is therefore exempt from FCC filing fee and regulatory fee requirements pursuant to Sections 1.1114 and Section 1.1162 of the FCC's Rules.

4. Transmitter Output Power.

Combined:	50,000 watts
Analog:	Not applicable (AM HD transmitter power is combined)
Digital:	Not applicable (AM HD transmitter power is combined)

- 5. Certification of ERP. Not applicable for AM transmitters.
- 6. *Radiation Exposure Certification.* ABOR hereby certifies that its digital operations will not cause human exposure to levels of radio frequency radiation in excess of Section 1.1310 of the Commission's rules and is therefore categorically excluded from environmental processing pursuant to Section 1.1306(b).
- 7. *For AM stations only*. The primary digital carrier power has been reduced by 0 dB from the iBiquity specified level.
