Commonwealth Public Broadcasting Corporation, licensee of station WCVE-FM, Richmond, Virginia, hereby notifies the Commission of the increase in digital power for the above referenced station. Consistent with the Commission's recent Order, Commonwealth Public Broadcasting hereby supplies the following information in support of this notification.

- 1. Commonwealth Public Broadcasting Corporation commenced the digital power increase on May 17, 2010.

- 3. The effective radiated power of the analog system is 17.5 kW. The digital ERP is 352 watts. The transmitter power output for the analog is 3.48 kW. The digital TPO is 70 Watts.
- 4. Commonwealth Public Broadcasting Corporation certifies that its operation conforms to the iBiquity Digital Corporation hybrid specifications.
- 5. Commonwealth Public Broadcasting Corporation certifies that its analog effective radiated power will remain as authorized.
