Dear Mr. Horton:

This letter concerns the request, filed on March 25, 2010 on behalf of Pensacola Christian College, Inc., for Special Temporary Authority to permit FM Translator Station W210BB to remain silent.

Pensacola Christian College, Inc.'s request states that W210BB went silent on March 23, 2010, in which to search for an alternate frequency. Pensacola Christian College, Inc.'s request includes the appropriate certification regarding Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988.<sup>1</sup>

Pensacola Christian College, Inc.'s request will be granted. Accordingly, Special Temporary Authority is granted to permit FM Translator Station W210BB to remain silent for a period not to exceed 180 days from the date of this letter. Notwithstanding the grant of this special temporary authority, the broadcast license for W210BB will automatically expire as a matter of law if broadcast operations do not commence by 12:01 a.m. March 24, 2011.<sup>2</sup> See Section 312(g) of the Communications Act, 47 U.S.C. Section 312(g).

The station's silent status does not suspend the licensee's obligation to comply with all other relevant Commission rules, including the filing, when appropriate, of applications for renewal of broadcast license. Finally, we note that it is imperative to the safety of air navigation that any prescribed painting and illumination of the station's tower shall be maintained until removed. *See* 47 C.F.R. Sections 17.6 and 73.1740(a)(4).
