**Request for Extension of Special Temporary Authority**

Dear Ms. Dortch:

On behalf of Public Broadcasting of Colorado, Inc. ("PBC"), licensee of noncommercial FM radio station KCFR-FM, Denver, Colorado, this is to request a further extension of the Special Temporary Authority ("STA") for PBC to operate KCFR-FM with a modified antenna at reduced power.

The Commission previously granted PBC special temporary authority ("STA") to operate KCFR-FM at reduced power due to certain RF radiation hotspots located near the KCFR-FM transmitter site on Lookout Mountain, outside Denver.

Good cause exists for a further extension of this STA in order to obviate any continued questions concerning RF exposure.

Accordingly, a further extension of the STA to continue KCFR-FM's reduced power operation at its licensed site, is required.

Submitted with this request is an Anti-Drug Abuse Certification. As PBC is the licensee of a noncommercial educational FM station, no filing fee is required for this request.


