Dear Counsel:

This is in reference to the license application to cover the above-captioned construction permit and the request for program test authority ("PTA") for WRTO.

Authority is granted WRTO to conduct program tests in accordance with Section 73.1620 of the Commission's Rules and the permit, BP-20000427AAB. WRTO shall operate on 1200 kHz with a nominal daytime power of 20 kilowatts and a nominal nighttime power of 4.5 kilowatts. Program tests are authorized with daytime antenna input power of 21.06 kilowatts (common point current 20.5 amperes), and with nighttime antenna input power of 4.86 kilowatts (common point current 9.86 amperes).

The authorized daytime antenna monitor parameters are as follows:
