Dear Licensee:

This is with respect to television station KEGS, Goldfield, Nevada, licensed to Nevada Channel 3, Inc., Debtor-in-Possession ("Nevada Channel 3"). Section 312(g) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended,<sup>1</sup> provides that:

If a broadcasting station fails to transmit broadcast signals for any consecutive 12-month period, then the station license granted for the operation of that broadcast station expires at the end of that period, notwithstanding any provision, term or condition of the license to the contrary . . .

KEGS ceased analog operations on June 12, 2009, when full power television stations were statutorily required to cease analog operations and provide a digital-only television service.<sup>2</sup> In addition, Nevada Channel 3's construction permit for its digital facility has expired and a license to cover was never filed. Accordingly, the license for KEGS IS HEREBY CANCELLED and the call sign IS DELETED.
