Dear Licensee:

This is with respect to the above referenced low power television stations in Alexandria, Louisiana licensed to MS Communications, Inc.. Section 312(g) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended,<sup>1</sup> provides that:

If a broadcasting station fails to transmit broadcast signals for any consecutive 12-month period, then the station license granted for the operation of that broadcast station expires at the end of that period, notwithstanding any provision, term or condition of the license to the contrary . . ..

Commission records indicate that the Alexandria stations have been silent since January 1, 2007. Accordingly, the licenses for the above-referenced stations ARE HEREBY CANCELLED and the call signs ARE DELETED.
