> Re: Application for a Low Power Television Facility to operate on Channel 33 at Nephi, Utah Facility ID No. 182150 BNPDTT-20090825BDN

Gentlemen:

This refers to the above-captioned application for a construction permit for a new television translator station to operate on Channel 33, at Nephi, Utah, filed on behalf of Juab County. A petition to deny that application was filed on behalf of Iron County.

Iron County requests that the Juab County application be denied because of potential interference to the UHF signal used to receive and extend the signal of KUTV, Salt Lake City, Utah, to southwest Utah. Specifically, Iron County argues that the interference likely to result from this proposed station would compromise signals used by approximately 22 other translator stations (including 13 licensed to and operated by Iron County) and 13 cable headends that relay the KUTV signal.

Iron County now seeks to withdraw its objection. It reports that it has received assurances from Juab County that the latter will not operate facilities that will interfere with the signals received by the subject stations and headends. Based on that representation, Iron County seeks to withdraw its objection. We will grant Iron County's request to withdraw its objection. A review of the matters raised herein, consistent with the obligation to determine whether the public interest, convenience and necessity will be served by approval of the parties' requests, does not appear to raise a question warranting further Commission action.<sup>1</sup> In this regard, Juab County has recognized that it will be required to avoid interference from its new station to existing stations and it will be responsible for addressing any objectionable interference that may result from implementation of its proposal.

In addition, our review of Juab County's above-captioned application indicates that it is legally and technically qualified to construct and operate with the facilities as proposed.

Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED that: the request to withdraw the objection filed by Iron County IS GRANTED, and that objection IS DISMISSED. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Juab County's application (BNPDTT-20090825BDN) for a new translator facility to operate on Channel 33, at Nephi, Utah, IS GRANTED.
