Dear Licensee:

This is with respect to the above-referenced stations licensed to Oregon Trail Broadcasting Company. Section 312(g) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended,¹ provides that:

If a broadcasting station fails to transmit broadcast signals for any consecutive 12-month period, then the station license granted for the operation of that broadcast station expires at the end of that period, notwithstanding any provision, term or condition of the license to the contrary . . .

Commission records indicate that above-referenced stations have been silent since March 5, 2008. Accordingly, the licenses for K12OE, K13VI and K13VJ ARE HEREBY CANCELLED and the call signs ARE DELETED.
