Dear Licensee:

This is with respect to above-referenced stations at various locations in Oregon licensed to Rural Oregon Wireless Television, Inc. Section 312(g) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended,<sup>1</sup> provides that:

If a broadcasting station fails to transmit broadcast signals for any consecutive 12-month period, then the station license granted for the operation of that broadcast station expires at the end of that period, notwithstanding any provision, term or condition of the license to the contrary . . ..

Commission records indicate that these stations have been silent since September 30, 2008.<sup>2</sup> Accordingly, the licenses for stations K26FG, K33CJ, K39ES, K41CL, K43FH, K46CU and K67AD ARE HEREBY CANCELLED and the call signs ARE DELETED.
