Dear Licensee:

This is with respect to low power television station WMDV-LP, Danville, Virginia. Section 312(g) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended,<sup>1</sup> provides that:

If a broadcasting station fails to transmit broadcast signals for any consecutive 12-month period, then the station license granted for the operation of that broadcast station expires at the end of that period, notwithstanding any provision, term or condition of the license to the contrary . . .

The above-referenced request for silent authority indicates that WMDV-LP has been silent since June 1, 2009. Accordingly, the request for silent authority IS DISMISSED, the license for WMDV-LP IS CANCELLED and the call sign IS DELETED.
