## Dear Licensee:

In accordance with procedures adopted by the Commission, <sup>1</sup> this letter constitutes notification to the University of Wyoming ("University"), licensee of Station KUWR(FM), Channel 220C, Laramie, Wyoming, <sup>2</sup> of the filing of minor change application BPH-20100301ADY (the "Application") by Kimball Radio, LLC ("Kimball"), licensee of Station KYOY(FM), Channel 222A, Hillsdale, Wyoming. The Application requests modification of the KUWR(FM) license to specify operation on channel 220C0 in lieu of channel 220C. <sup>3</sup>

Section 316(a) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended,<sup>4</sup> permits us to modify a license or construction permit if such action is in the public interest. The Act requires that we notify the affected station of the proposed action, the public interest reasons for the action, and afford the licensee/permittee of the affected station at least 30 days to respond. This procedure is set forth in Section 1.87 of the Commission's Rules.<sup>5</sup> We find that the Application has sufficient public interest benefits to justify the issuance of a show cause order.

Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED, that pursuant to Section 316(a) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, 47 U.S.C. § 316(a), and pursuant to Section 1.87 of the Commission's Rules, University SHALL SHOW CAUSE why its license SHOULD NOT BE MODIFIED to specify Channel 220C0 in lieu of Channel 220C. University may, not later than 30 days from the date of this letter, file a written statement showing with particularity why its license should not be modified as proposed in this *Order to Show Cause*. The Commission may call upon the affected licensee herein to furnish additional information. If the affected licensee raises any substantial and material questions of fact, a hearing may be required to resolve such questions of fact pursuant to Section 1.87 of the Rules. Upon review of the statements and/or additional information furnished, the Commission may grant the modification, deny the modification, or set the matter of modification for hearing. If no written statement is filed within the period specified above, the licensee will be deemed to have consented to the modification as proposed in this *Order to Show Cause* and its assignment will be modified to specify the reduced class.

Further action on the Application will be withheld for 30 days from the date of this letter to provide University an opportunity to reply. Please note that responses must be submitted to the Secretary of the Commission in triplicate and must be served on all parties.
