Radio Disney Sacramento, LLC Special Temporary Authorization

Dear Counsel:

This is in reference to the request filed August 2, 2010, on behalf of Radio Disney Sacramento, LLC ("RDS"). RDS seeks further extension of the special temporary authority ("STA") granted on July 17, 2009, to operate Station KIID with an emergency nondirectional antenna and reduced power. In support of the request, RDS provides a report of its progress toward restoring licensed operatin since two of the station's towers and associated equipment were destroyed by a fire. RDS provides a list of tasks which have been completed, and states that the project has been delayed by discovery of a one-second coordinate discrepancy.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Our review indicates that the licensee has made substantial progress toward restoration of licensed operation. Thus, extension of STA is warranted.

Accordingly, the request for extension of STA IS HEREBY GRANTED. Station KIID may

¹ KIID is licensed for operation on 1470 kHz with 5 kilowatts daytime and 1 kilowatt nighttime, employing different directional antenna patterns daytime and nighttime (DA-2-U).

continue to operate with an emergency nondirectional antenna and reduced power not to exceed 1.25 kilowatts daytime and 0.25 kilowatt nighttime. It will be necessary to further reduce power or cease operation if complaints of interference are received. RDS must notify the Commission when licensed operation is restored.² RDS must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR § 1.1310.

This authority expires on February 26, 2011.
