Hossein,

Please dismiss the above-captioned application of WXTV-DT for distributed transmission facility operation in the New York City market.

This application was one of several filed by NYC-area stations to implement a DTS site in Brooklyn, to fill in areas not well served due to obstruction of the propagation path by the tower at the Empire State Building to which their antennas are mounted. What was actually sought was an experimental authorization, but Kevin Harding requested that we file our technical facility parameters as DTS CP applications, as a "means of importing the data" for use in granting the experimental authority. Our understanding was that, once filed, the data would be extracted and the CP applications deleted from CDBS.

The DTS facility was to be constructed by the Metropolitan Television Alliance (MTVA), using funds from a legislative grant administered by the NTIA. However, just before a lease was to be signed for the site, a majority of the MTVA members voted to terminate its development. WXTV-DT did not and does not seek to build such a facility on its own. Accordingly, there is no longer any reason to maintain this entry in the CDBS.
