On September 16, 2009, the licensee as addressed above was sent a 30 day deficiency letter outlining the following interference problems:

Our preliminary engineering review reveals that your proposed facility does not comply with the Commission's interference rules. Specifically, the proposal is predicted to cause interference to the following facilities:

WTNZ BMLCDT-20040706ABG CHANNEL 34 KNOXVILLE, TN WTNZ BPCDT-20080619ABZ CHANNEL 34 KNOXVILLE, TN

You were given the opportunity to file a minor amendment to resolve these specified problems within (30) days from the date of that letter. Your amendment must be filed electronically. If not so amended, your application will be considered incomplete and subsequently dismissed.

Our records show that no amendment has been filed as of September 14, 2010, to resolve the above referenced interference problems. In addition, our current interference analysis shows the same interference issues still exist as outlined in the above letter.

Further review shows that you have filed a second displacement application BDISDVL-20091015ADX which supersedes the above referenced displacement application. You can not have two displacement applications pending at the same time; therefore, as a result of the ongoing interference problems and the filing of a second pending displacement application the above referenced displacement application BDISDTL-20090701AAE IS HEREBY DISMISSED.
