Dear Mr. Miller:

This letter refers to the pending application of First Western, Inc., for renewal application of Station KNJY(AM), Boise, Idaho.

We cannot process the application and have been holding it since May 26, 2005, pursuant to the Commission's "red light" rules, which prohibit the staff from granting an application when an applicant is delinquent on debts owed to the Commission.¹ We believe that it is not in the public interest to retain unprocessable applications for extended periods of time, particularly when the extended delay is the result of the inaction of an applicant to correct a debt delinquency.²

Accordingly, we are providing First Western, Inc., a period of 30 days from the date of this letter to pay or arrange for payment of the delinquent debt with the Commission's Office of Managing Director.³



Failure to have the “red light” status removed within that time period will result in the dismissal of the referenced application pursuant to Sections 1.1910(b)(3) and 73.3568(a)(1) of the Commission’s Rules.⁴
