Request For Special Temporary
Authority To Remain Silent

Dear Licensee:

This letter concerns the request, filed on August 5, 2010, for Special Temporary Authority to permit FM Station KRID to remain silent.

Your request states that KRID(FM) went silent on July 11, 2010, for financial reasons. Your request includes the appropriate certification regarding Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988.¹

Your request will be granted. Accordingly, Special Temporary Authority is granted to permit Station KRID(FM) to remain silent not to exceed 180 days from the date of this letter. **Notwithstanding the grant of this special temporary authority, the broadcast license for KRID(FM) will automatically expire as a matter of law if broadcast operations do not commence by 12:01 a.m., July 12, 2011.**² See Section 312(g) of the Communications Act, 47 U.S.C. Section 312(g).


The station's silent status does not suspend the licensee's obligation to comply with all other relevant Commission rules, including the filing, when appropriate, of applications for renewal of broadcast license. Finally, we note that it is imperative to the safety of air navigation that any

broadcast license. Finally, we note that it is imperative to the safety of air navigation that any prescribed painting and illumination of the station's tower shall be maintained until removed. See 47 C.F.R. Sections 17.6 and 73.1740(a)(4).
