Request For Special Temporary  
Authority To Remain Silent

Dear Mr. Wagner:

This letter concerns the requests, filed on July 9, 2010, on behalf of Urban Radio Communications, LLC ("Urban"), for Special Temporary Authority to permit AM Stations WVNA and WLAY to remain silent.

Urban's requests state that WVNA(AM) and WLAY(AM) went silent on June 28, 2010, due to the stations' loss of their transmitter site. Urban's requests include the appropriate certification regarding Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988.<sup>1</sup>

Urban's requests will be granted. Accordingly, Special Temporary Authority is granted to permit Stations WVNA(AM) and WLAY(AM) to remain silent not to exceed 180 days from the date of this letter. **Notwithstanding the grant of this special temporary authority, the broadcast licenses for WVNA(AM) and WLAY(AM) will automatically expire as a matter**

**of law if broadcast operations do not commence by 12:01 a.m., June 29, 2011.**<sup>2</sup> *See* Section 312(g) of the Communications Act, 47 U.S.C. Section 312(g).

The stations' silent status does not suspend the licensee's obligation to comply with all other relevant Commission rules, including the filing, when appropriate, of applications for renewal of broadcast license. Finally, we note that it is imperative to the safety of air navigation that any prescribed painting and illumination of the stations' tower shall be maintained until removed. *See* 47 C.F.R. Sections 17.6 and 73.1740(a)(4).
