Request For Special Temporary  
Authority To Remain Silent

Dear Mr. Tucker:

This letter concerns the requests, filed on August 9, 2010, on behalf of Cochise Media Licenses LLC (Cochise”), for Special Temporary Authority to permit FM Stations KCYA and KXWY to remain silent.

Cochise’s requests state that KCYA(FM) and KXWY(FM) went silent on July 10, 2010, due to the stations finalizing programming arrangements for its FM stations in the Casper and Riverton, Wyoming radio markets. Cochise’s requests include the appropriate certification regarding Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988.<sup>1</sup>

Cochise’s requests will be granted. Accordingly, Special Temporary Authority is granted to permit Stations KCYA(FM) and KXWY(FM) to remain silent not to exceed 180 days from the date of this letter. **Notwithstanding the grant of this special temporary authority, the broadcast licenses for KCYA(FM) and KXWY(FM) will automatically expire as a matter**



**of law if broadcast operations do not commence by 12:01 a.m., July 11, 2011.**<sup>2</sup> See Section 312(g) of the Communications Act, 47 U.S.C. Section 312(g).

The stations' silent status does not suspend the licensee's obligation to comply with all other relevant Commission rules, including the filing, when appropriate, of applications for renewal of broadcast license. Finally, we note that it is imperative to the safety of air navigation that any prescribed painting and illumination of the station's tower shall be maintained until removed. See 47 C.F.R. Sections 17.6 and 73.1740(a)(4).
