Request For Extension of Special
Temporary Authority To Remain Silent

Dear Mr. Manzo:

This letter concerns the request, filed on August 24, 2010, on behalf of Ondas De Vida Network, Inc. ("Ondas"), for Special Temporary Authority to permit FM Translator Station K215FA to remain silent.

Commission records reflect that K215FA went silent on February 22, 2010, due to potential interference to the reception of another station. On March 2, 2010, Ondas requested an STA for the station to remain silent until the interference issues were resolved. The STA was granted April 15, 2010, and expired October 13, 2010. Ondas' current request states that a solution to the interference issues is still being pursued. Accordingly, Ondas requests that the STA be extended. Ondas' request includes the appropriate certification regarding Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988.


Ondas' request will be granted. Accordingly, Special Temporary Authority is granted to permit Station K215FA to remain silent until February 22, 2011. **Notwithstanding the grant of this special temporary authority, the broadcast license for K215FA will automatically expire as a matter of law if broadcast operations do not commence by 12:01 a.m., February 23, 2011.**¹ See Section 312(g) of the Communications Act, 47 U.S.C. Section 312(g).

The station's silent status does not suspend the licensee's obligation to comply with all other relevant Commission rules, including the filing, when appropriate, of applications for renewal of broadcast license. Finally, we note that it is imperative to the safety of air navigation that any prescribed painting and illumination of the stations' towers shall be maintained. See 47 C.F.R. Sections 17.6 and 73.1740(a)(4).
