Temple University of the Commonwealth System of Higher Education ("Temple") hereby notifies the Commission of an increase in hybrid IBOC power at noncommercial educational station WRTI(FM), Philadelphia, PA, Facility ID 65190, consistent with to the Commission's Public Notice, DA-10-866, released May 17, 2010, specifying procedures to be utilized pending OMB Approval of Form 335. Temple notified the Commission of initial hybrid digital operation under File No. BDNE-20050531BYT.

Temple hereby supplies the following information in support of this notification, as required by the Public Notice:

1. *Date.* WRTI began digital broadcasts with increased power on October 26, 2010.
2. *Certification of Facilities.* Temple hereby certifies that with the exception of the digital ERP, the digital facilities of WRTI conform to the iBiquity Digital Corporation hybrid FM specifications.

Analog: 7400 watts average
Digital: 296 watts
Combined: 7696 watts

5. *Effective Radiated Power:*

Analog: 7700 watts H, 7700 watts V
Digital: 308 watts H, 308 watts V

6. *Radiation Exposure Certification.* Temple hereby certifies that the interim digital operations of WRTI will not cause human exposure to levels of radio frequency radiation in excess of Section 1.1310 of the Commission's rules and is therefore categorically excluded from environmental processing pursuant to Section 1.1306(b).
