Dear Applicant:

An engineering study of the above-captioned minor change application reveals that the proposed transmitter site fails to meet the minimum spacing requirements of 47 C.F.R. § 73.807. Specifically, the site proposed is 121 kilometers from the licensed facility of co-channel Class C0 Station KKLD, Cottonwood, AZ (Facility ID No.: 51642). The required spacing pursuant to § 73.807 is 122 kilometers.¹

In addition, the site proposed is 6 kilometers away from the currently authorized facility. The *Second Report & Order* in MM Docket 99-25 established the definition of a "minor change" as it applies to LPFM applications.² The Commission stated that minor changes to LP100 applications would be limited to those specifying changes in site of 5.6 kilometers or less. Thus, the application specifying a 6 kilometer change in site violates 47 C.F.R. § 73.871.

In light of the above, application BPL-20101123AMM is unacceptable for filing and IS HEREBY DISMISSED. This action is taken pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 0.283.
