Dear Mr. Langham:

This is in reference to the request filed December 3, 2010, on behalf of Citicasters Licenses, Inc. ("Citicasters"). Citicasters requests extension of the special temporary authority ("STA") granted on June 4, 2010, to operate Station WDDV with parameters at variance and/or reduced power while maintaining monitor points within licensed limits, and for operation with a nondirectional antenna and reduced power.¹ In support of the request, Citicasters states that it has completed installation of an FM antenna on one of the WDDV towers, and that adjustment and partial proof of performance measurements have been completed.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.


Our review indicates that the licensee has made substantial progress toward restoring licensed operation. Thus, extension of STA is warranted. Based on the information provided, nondirectional operation is no longer required; the STA is modified accordingly.

¹ WDDV is licensed for operation on 1320 kHz with 5 kilowatts daytime and 1 kilowatt nighttime, employing different directional antenna patterns daytime and nighttime (DA-2-U).

Accordingly, the request for extension of STA IS HEREBY GRANTED, with modification as discussed above. Station WDDV may continue to operate with parameters at variance and/or reduced power while maintaining monitor points within licensed limits. It will be necessary to further reduce power or cease operation if complaints of interference are received. It is anticipated that an application for direct measurement of operating power will be filed in the near future. Citicasters must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. See 47 CFR § 1.1310.

This authority expires on **July 11, 2011**.
