**Re: Supplement to Request for Special Temporary Authority to Remain Silent
FCC File No. BLSTA-20091204AAH
KXPC-FM, Lebanon, Oregon (FIN: 61987)**

Dear Ms. Dortch:

On behalf of Educational Media Foundation ("EMF"), the licensee of FM radio station KXPC-FM, Lebanon, Oregon, this is a supplement to the request filed on December 4, 2009 for Special Temporary Authority ("STA") to allow KXPC-FM to remain silent. This supplement is being submitted to update the Commission regarding KXPC-FM's operational status since that time.

In its STA request, the prior license of KXPC-FM notified the FCC that technical difficulties caused temporary discontinuance of operations at KXPC-FM on December 3, 2009. On December 18, 2009, EMF consummated its acquisition of KXPC-FM and learned that the authorized KXPC-FM tower was being torn down by the tower site owner. As a result, EMF made preparations to move KXPC-FM to a new tower site and received FCC approval to do so in January 2010. See FCC File No. BPED-20091223AOC. EMF is still working to construct the modified facilities. However, on July 31, 2010, prior to the tower site owner's demolition of the authorized tower site, EMF resumed KXPC-FM's operations at full power according to its licensed parameters. For approximately one hour and thirty minutes, KXPC-FM broadcast EMF's K-LOVE's programming and the appropriate station identification. Thereafter, EMF discontinued operations at KXPC-FM and decommissioned the equipment to allow for demolition of the tower. Please update the Commission's records regarding this resumption of operations. EMF is currently working diligently to construct KXPC-FM's modified facilities as authorized by FCC File No. BPED-20091223AOC. In the interim, EMF renews the initial request for an STA to allow KXPC-FM to remain silent.


