Dear Mr. Naftalin:

This letter refers to the above-captioned application, and the July 29, 2009, amendment for a new AM station at Lemon Grove, California.

A preliminary review of the amended application reveals that the proposed daytime 5 mV/m contour does not cover 100% of the city of Lemon Grove, California, in violation of Section 73.24(i) of the Commission's rules.¹

Further action on the subject application will be withheld for a period of thirty (30) days from the date of this letter to provide an opportunity to file a curative amendment.² Failure to amend or respond within this time period will result in the dismissal of the application pursuant to Section 73.3568 of the Commission's rules.

¹ CBI states that the proposed 5.0 mV/m daytime contour will provide 81.3 % coverage of Lemon Grove, and will provide 84.7 % of the total population of Lemon Grove. However, the Commission's 80% coverage policy only applies to nighttime operations.

² CBI is reminded that all measurement data graphs and tabulation pages from the original application must be resubmitted when an amendment is filed, because previous versions of the application are superseded each time an amendment is filed.
