Dear Applicant :

You have indicated that your station is displaced based on Section 73.3572(a)(4)(iv)(A) of the Commission's rules, which provides displacement relief for Class A, low power TV and TV translator stations which are located within specified distances from co-channel full power DTV facilities or allotment references coordinates. At the time this Section of the rules was adopted in 1998, many full power television stations had not yet transitioned to digital broadcasting or were not operating with the maximum power permitted under the rules. By June 12, 2009, however, all full power television stations transitioned to digital-only operations, and these stations largely operate with their maximum allowable facilities. In order to prevent the processing of unnecessary displacement applications, you are hereby required to amend your application, within 30 days from the date of this letter, to submit an engineering showing demonstrating that your station is causing or receiving actual or predicted interference from a full power DTV station. Failure to do so may result in the dismissal of your application
