This is in response to your April 21, 2011 email to Barbara Kreisman. By letters dated March 23, 2011, the Video Division requested information from Gary M. and Deborah R. Kenney, the licensees of Class A television stations KCLJ-CA, Joplin, Missouri and KCLG-CA, Neosho, Missouri, regarding the failure to make the required quarterly Form 398 electronic filings for the stations for the past four years. The Division letters also stated that if the failure to make the quarterly filings was due to the Kenney's election to let the stations revert to low power television status, they need only notify the Commission of this election and request a change in status for the stations as permitted by Section 73.6001(d) of the Commission's rules.

In your email, you request a change in status for KCLJ-CA and KCLG-CA from Class A to low power television status. Please be informed that we have changed the status of the stations as requested, as well as the status of the digital flash-cut construction permit for KCLJ-CA (File No. BDFCDTA-20100813CAI). Please be informed that no further action is required of Gary M. and Deborah R. Kenney,
