Petition for Reconsideration


Dear Applicant:

The staff has under consideration: (1) the above-captioned application for W283BQ, Ithaca, New York, BPFT-20100920ADN; (2) Petition for Reconsideration of the grant of BNPFT-20080620ADO filed by Saga Communications of New England, LLC ("Saga") on August 11, 2010; and, (3) all related pleadings. For the reasons set forth herein, we dismiss the Petition for Reconsideration as moot.

Saga purports, in the Petition for Reconsideration filed on August 11, 2010, that the proposed translator (BNPFT-20080620ADO) would cause interference to WOLF-FM, Deruyter, New York. WOLF-FM is licensed to Foxfur Communication, LLC. Foxfur Communications, LLC has not filed a petition concerning this application. In Saga's petition, Saga states that there is an error in the coordinates (BNPFT-20080620ADO) that require a new FCC Form 349 to be filed. Robert A Lynch filed a modification application on September 20, 2010 to change the transmitter site. At the proposed site, there is no prohibited overlap with WOLF-FM.

Accordingly, the August 11, 2010 Petition for Reconsideration filed by Saga IS HEREBY DISMISSED AS MOOT and BPFT-20100920ADN IS HEREBY GRANTED. This action is taken pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 0.283.
