This is in reference to the above captioned license application, which was granted on February 8, 2001, and the February 22, 2011, Request for Relief (Request) filed by Fifth Avenue Broadcasting Company, Inc. (Fifth Avenue), licensee of station WRVC(AM), Huntington, West Virginia. In the Request, Fifth Avenue asks that the missing special condition to protect WRVC(AM) in WNBL's construction permit BMJP-20051031AFF be added to the application BL-20110103ACY.<sup>1</sup>

A preliminary review of the application reveals the special condition was erroneously omitted from BL-20110103ACY. Accordingly, the Request filed by Fifth Avenue is hereby granted, and the license BL-20110103ACY is hereby reissued to include the WRVC(AM) special condition.
