Dear Ms. Dortch:

On behalf of Entercom Boston License, LLC, licensee of WAAF(FM), Westborough, MA (Facility Id. No. 74467) ("Station"), this letter serves to respond to your letter dated September 16, 2008 requesting an update of Station's signal coverage problems from its site authorized under construction permit BPH-20030228AJE.

1. Station is currently operating from construction permit facilities authorized under BPH-20030228AJE.

2. Station determined that the signal coverage problems were caused by a problem related to the Station's T1 STL system. After conducting several non-conventional tests outside the routine telco performance protocols on Station's T-1 circuit, Station discovered that the source of the multi-path like sound was caused by a complicated interaction with the digital program being fed from the studio, through the T-1 program circuit and into the Station's stereo generator and transmitter. Station resolved the coverage problems by installing replacement circuit cards for the T-1 interface equipment. After conducting drive around field tests, Station was able to confirm that its coverage problems had been resolved.

3. Station intends to continue its operations from the site authorized in construction permit BPH-20030228AJE. Accordingly, Station respectfully requests that the Commission reinstate the grant of license BLH-20051019ABP to cover the underlying construction permit (BPH-20030228AJE).


