Dear Licensee:

This letter concerns the request, filed on June 7, 2011, on behalf of Jackman Holding Company, LLC ("Jackman"), for extension of its Special Temporary Authority to permit FM Station KLMZ to remain silent.

Commission records reflect that KLMZ(FM) went silent on October 18, 2010, due to financial difficulty. The previous STA was granted on December 7, 2010, and expired on June 7, 2011. Jackman requests extension of its STA due to continued financial difficulty. The request includes the appropriate certification regarding Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988.


Jackman's request will be granted. Accordingly, Special Temporary Authority is granted to permit Station KLMZ(FM) to remain silent for a period not to exceed October 18, 2011. **Notwithstanding the grant of this special temporary authority, the broadcast license for KLMZ(FM) will automatically expire as a matter of law if broadcast operations do not commence by 12:01 a.m. on October 19, 2011.**¹ See Section 312(g) of the Communications Act, 47 U.S.C. Section 312(g).

The station's silent status does not suspend the licensee's obligation to comply with all other relevant Commission rules, including the filing, when appropriate, of applications for renewal of broadcast license. Finally, we note that it is imperative to the safety of air navigation that any prescribed painting and illumination of the station's tower shall be maintained until removed. See 47 C.F.R. Sections 17.6 and 73.1740(a)(4).
