Dear Licensee:

Your license for the above-referenced station expired on June 1, 1996. An application for renewal of this station's license should have been filed by February 1, 1996. By letter of January 17, 1997, you were informed that failure to file a license renewal application by February 6, 1997, could result in action terminating your authority to operate the station and deletion of your station's call letters.

To date, we have no record of receiving a license renewal application for the above-referenced station and your license has expired by its own terms. Accordingly, your authority to operate KXLA, RAYVILLE, LA IS TERMINATED and your call letters ARE DELETED.

Finally, it is imperative to the safety of air navigation that you maintain the prescribed painting and illumination of your tower until it is dismantled. Accordingly, you ARE HEREBY DIRECTED, pursuant to 47 U.S.C. Section 303(q), to maintain the tower of the above-referenced station in the manner prescribed by our rules and the terms of your expired license. See, 47 C.F.R. Sections 17.1 et.seq. and 73.1213.
