Request for Special Temporary Authority to Remain Silent

Dear Mr. Callison:

This letter concerns the request you filed on July 18, 2011, on behalf of Friends of Public Radio, Inc. ("FPR") for Special Temporary Authority to permit FM Translator Station W255BZ to remain silent.

FPR's request states that Station W255BZ went silent on June 17, 2011, because it lost its tower lease. FPR's request includes the appropriate certification regarding Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988.¹

FPR's request will be granted. Accordingly, Special Temporary Authority is granted to permit Station W255BZ to remain silent not to exceed 180 days from the date of this letter. **Notwithstanding the grant of this Special Temporary Authority, the broadcast license for Station W255BZ will automatically expire as a matter of law if broadcast operations do not commence by 12:01 a.m., June 16, 2012.² See Section 312(g) of the Communications Act, 47 U.S.C. § 312(g).**

² Notification of resumption of broadcast operations must be mailed to:

The station's silent status does not suspend the licensee's obligation to comply with all other relevant Commission rules, including the filing, when appropriate, of applications for renewal of broadcast license. Finally, we note that it is imperative to the safety of air navigation that any prescribed painting and illumination of the station's tower shall be maintained until removed. *See* 47 C.F.R. §§ 17.6 and 73.1740(a)(4).
